- Now write the rules of making plurals:
- We add '-s' to the words ending in vowel or consonant sound to make it plural.
- We add '-es' to make plural if the word ends in -sh, -ch, -x, oz -z.
- We add 'ies' to make plural if the word ends in '-y'. 'y' is removed before adding 'ies'.
- After this, ask students to solve the exercise on book C2(i).
- Once they have done, tell them the correct answers.
- Praise them for their active participation.

Conclusion: (3 min)

Conclude the lesson by explaining them the concept again.

Revision: (7 min)

Provide them a worksheet to solve.
