## Teaching Methodology:

Warm Up: (10 min)

- Welcome students in the class with a bright smile.
- Greet them with "Assalaam-o-Alaikum" and encourage them to reply with "Wa Alaikum Assalaam".
- Say "Bismillah" first and tell them to recite it before starting any activity.
- First, introduce yourself to them. For example:

My good name is \_\_\_\_\_\_. I am your new English teacher.

- Make them sit with discipline.
- Tell them the classroom and school rules.
- Tell them that today they'll have an activity "Let's Know to Each Other" and all the students will participate in it.
- Now, ask them to tell their names one by one in order to introduce themselves to the class.
- Now ask them to share their hobbies one by one.
- Keep a smile on your face and maintain eye contact with the students. Make sure that all students are participating in the discussion.
- Encourage them to speak confidently.
- Tell them that a number of fun/informative activities will be held in the class together.
- Tell them that we will learn about innovative ideas in the class.

## Discussion: (20 min)

- Tell students that today they'll learn about each other and how to introduce ourselves.
- Write different questions on board as given below and ask students one by one to answer them:

What is your good name? [In which class do you read?]

What is the name of your parents?

How many sisters do you have? How many brothers do you have?

Which is your favourite colour? What is your hobby?

- Encourage them to participate in discussion.
- Give them positive remarks such as "good, excellent, well done, etc.," on their active response in class discussion.

## Conclusion: (5 min)

• Summarize the key concepts to students that what includes in introduction.

• Provide them the worksheet to solve.

## Revision: (5 min)


Ask them at random to share more examples of the concept you ask.



## Teaching Methodology:

## Warm Up: (5 min)

- Greet students with Assalaam-o-Alaikum and let them reply as well.
- Start with Bismillah and teach them to recite it before starting any task.
- Make students sit with discipline.
- Ask students about their favourite poem.
- Let them share their ideas.
- Encourage them to participate in discussion.

## Discussion: (25 min)

- Write the title of the poem on whiteboard and ask students to read it aloud.
- Encourage them to share their ideas on the title one by one.
- Now ask them to open textbook page 4.
- Show them the given picture on the page and have them share their ideas on the picture.
- Next, read the questions from 'Getting started' and 'Let's talk' section.
- Ask them to give answers and share their thoughts.
- Tell them the techniques of pre-reading strategies to predict a poem/lesson. Title and pictures help us to predict a poem/lesson.
- Praise them for their correct answers and active participation.

## Conclusion: (2 min)

• Summarize the key concepts of the discussion.

## Revision: (3 min)

### Teaching Methodology:

#### Warm Up: (5 min)

- Greet students with "Assalaam-o-Alaikum" and ask for their wellbeing.
- Start with Bismillah and teach them that we should start every task with Bismillah.
- Ask students to share their ideas on the poem and guess what the poem can be about by revising the concepts they learnt on previous day.

### Discussion: (25 min)

- Tell students that today they will recite a poem.
- Ask them to open textbook page 5.
- Read the statement aloud from 'pre-reading' section.
- Encourage them to give answers.
- Now recite the poem aloud and ask students to repeat it after you.
- Explain them the poem stanza to stanza and ask them to underline the difficult words from it. Explain them the meanings also.
- Ask students to recite the poem again by their own and ask the questions if they have any confusion.
- Tell them the theme of the poem and write it down on the whiteboard "Honesty is the best policy".
- Tell them we should always tell the truth. Telling the truth saves us from big problems.
- Share different examples of telling the truth with them by giving them the reference of Islam.
- Have them share their thoughts and ideas on it.

- Now ask them questions from the section 'post-reading' and let them answer one by one.
- Praise them for their active participation discussion.

## Conclusion: (5 min)

• Discuss the theme of the poem in detail.

## Revision: (3 min)

• Ask at random different questions related to poem and encourage them to give answers with confidence.

## Homework: (2 min)

• Ask students to recite the complete poem from textbook page 5 with correct rhythm, intonation and pronunciation.

## Revision: (6 min)

• Ask students one by one to tell the meaning of the word you ask.
