- Ask students to open their textbook page 17 and see Q No. 2.
- Recall the concept of ascending and descending order, by telling them that moving from smallest number to the greatest is ascending order.
 While moving from greatest to the smallest is descending order.

Make three groups on the board. Draw 2 pencils in one group, 4 pencils in second group and 6 pencils in third group. Now ask the students that which group has more pencils and which has fewer pencils. Take their response.

Tell the students that among 6, 2 and 4, 6 is the greatest and 2 is smallest number. Now arrange these numbers in ascending and descending order.

Ascending order:	2	4	6
Descending order:	6	4	2

Tell the students to comparing the numbers we can arrange them in ascending and descending order.

Take their response and tell them that now he/she has one bundle of 10 match sticks and 2 sticks that represent 12 sticks or number 12. Repeat this activity for the numbers 13, 14, ..., 20. Instruct students to write numbers 11 – 20 in their notebooks.

Review: 3mins

Ask students to open their textbooks to page 18. Ask them to count the number of pencils and read the number. Roam around the class and ask them to count and read the number in a loud voice.

Evaluation: 5mins

Assess the students understanding by drawing 16 objects on the board and ask them to count the objects and tell how many ones and tens are there in the number 16.



Now, ask him/her to take two balls and ask: How many balls do you have now? Take their responses and tell them that now he/she has 20 balls and 2 more ball. Tell them that 20 and 2 makes 22. Repeat this activity for the numbers 23, 24, ..., 30.
- Ask students to open their textbooks to page 19. Ask them to count the number of pencils and read the numbers also write numbers 21-30 in their notebooks.

Review: 3mins

Ask the students to count and read numbers 21 to 30.

Evaluation: 5mins

Assess the students learning by asking them to solve exercise 1.8 on page 20.

Encourage and appreciate them for their good work.


