Warm-up Activities:

5mins

Before beginning the lesson, ask students to say "Tasmiyah".

Ask students about their homework. Write random numbers up to 80 on the board. Ask students to say the spelling of their number names in a loud voice. Appreciate them for their correct answers.

Teaching and Learning Activities:

- 20 mins
- Tell students they are going to read and write numbers from 81 to 100 in numerals and words.
- Paste a wallchart of numbers up to 100 on the board. Say the number 81 and ask students to follow you and say the number names from 81 to 89 and their spelling in a loud voice. Point to number 90 and tell students the number name for 90 is 'ninety'. Say number and number names 90 to 99 and their spelling and ask them to repeat them with you. Point to the number 100 and tell them that we use the number name 'hundred' for this number. Ask them to repeat the number name for 100 and their spelling aloud.
- Now play a game with students by giving different number name cards to random students. Also write these numbers on board. Now call out the number and instruct student who have, calling number name card come to the board and paste it under that number. Appreciate them for their active participation.

Review:

Sum up the lesson by asking students to read number and numbers names up to 81-100 on page 7 of the textbook.

Evaluation:





Now ask the second group to write numbers and the first group members to write the number names for that numbers. Appreciate them for their active participation.

Warm-up Activities:

5mins

Before beginning the lesson, ask students to say "Tasmiyah".Ask student: How many ones are in one ten? How many tens are in one hundred? Take their responses and appreciate them for their correct answers.Teaching and Learning Activities: 20 mins

- Tell students that they are going to read and write numbers up to 999.
- Tell students we can read and write numbers with the help of number blocks. Draw ones, tens and hundreds blocks on the board and tell students about it. Draw ten ones blocks and ask them to count and tell how many are of these blocks. Take their responses that must be 10 blocks. Tell the students when ten ones block join together, they make 1 tens block; and when 10 tens blocks join together, they make 100. Draw 4 hundred blocks, 3 tens blocks and 4 ones blocks to represent numbers 434 on the board. Now call a student to the front of the class and ask them to count each type of block and write the number of blocks below each of them. After this ask students to read the number by joining that numbers together. Tell them that we can read this number as four hundred and thirty-four. Repeat this activity by drawing different numbers of blocks.
- Ask students to open their textbooks at page 10 and 11. Ask the students to count the blocks and read the numbers given on page 7 of their textbook. Tell them that 100 ones make one hundred and 100 is the smallest 3-digit number and 999 is the greatest 3-digit number.
