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



محمر علی سد پارہ پاکستان کے ہیرو اور ایک ورسٹائل کوہ بیا کے طور پر جانے جاتے ہیں۔ وہ واحد پا کستانی ہیں جنھوں نے دُنیا کے بلند ترین پہاڑوں میں سے آٹھ کی کوہ پیائی کی۔ وہ واحد ہیں جنھوں نے سردیوں میں سب سے پہلی دفعہ دُنیا کی بلندترین چوٹی، نانگا پربت کی چڑھائی کی۔

محم علی سدیارہ 1976ء میں پاکستان کے ایک گاؤں سدیارہ میں پیدا ہوئے۔ ان کے والد صاحب

ایک نچلے درجے کے سرکاری ملازم تھے۔ کوہ بیائی کے شوق کی طرف آنے سے

پہلے، انھوں نے اپنی پڑھائی سکردو کے ایک ہائر سکنٹرری سکول کے مل کی۔ ''ان میں ایک کھلاڑی کا جسم اور ایک کھلاڑی کی عادات تھیں اور وہ پڑھائی

میں بھی اچھے تھے۔''

2016ء میں انھوں نے سردیوں میں تین ممبران کی ٹیم میں سے نانگا پربت کی اُونچائی چڑھ کر دُنیا بھر میں شہرت حاصل کی۔

وہ جسمانی طور پر کوئی بھی چیلنج قبول کرنے کے لیے صحت مند تھے اور اپنے کام کو پورا کرنے کا عزم رکھتے تھے۔ ان کے ایک دوست کا کہنا ہے: ''وہ بہادر، اور خوشگوار، اور بہت دوستانہ تھے۔''

جمعہ 5 فروری کو محمر علی سدیارہ اپنے دو ساتھیوں آئس لینڈ کے جان سنوری اور چلی کے جان پابلومہر کے ساتھ لا پہتہ

ہو گئے۔ وہ K2 (وُنیا کی دوسری بلندترین چوٹی) کو چڑھنے کی مہم پر تھے جو کہ 8,611 میٹر سے 28,251 فٹ سمندر کی گہرائی کے اُوپرتھی۔ K2 کوسب سے خو فناک اور خطرناک پہاڑ سمجھا جاتا ہے۔

علی سد بارہ آئسیجن کے بغیر K2 کو باپ بیٹے کی جوڑی میں سر بارکرنا چاہتے تھے۔ (ایسا کارنامہ جوسردیوں میں پہلے بھی نہیں کیا گیا تھا)۔

لیکن برشمتی ہے، ان کا بیٹا ساجد بیار ہو گیا (آکسیجن کی پریشانی کی وجہ ہے) اور بوٹلنیک (Bottleneck) سے واپسی کرلی۔ اس کے بعد علی سد بارہ اور ان کے دو ساتھیوں کی تلاش کے لیے ریسکیو ٹیمیں بھیجی گئیں۔لیکن آخر کار، تلاش 18 فروری کو بند کر دی گئی اور تینوں کوہ بیاؤں کو مردہ قرار دے دیا گیا۔ ساجد اپنا بچھتاوا اورغم ظاہر کرتا ہے: "K2 نے میرے والد صاحب کو ہمیشہ کے لیے آغوش میں لے لیا ہے۔'

بلاشبہ، پاکستان نے ایک بہادر اور پر جوش کوہ بیا کو کھودیا ہے لیکن ان کی بہادری پاکستان کی تاریخ میں ہمیشہ یاد رکھی جائے گی۔

The queen disguised herself as an old woman and offered an apple to Snow White to eat. The apple was cursed.




