Subject: English Day: 01



Student Learning Outcomes

Students will be able to:

- recognize the letter "f" and pronunce its sound.
- learn simple vocabulary of the letter "f".

Teacher's Note

- Topic key points/ Introduction:
- The sound of leter f is /fff/fff/fff/
- Key Vocabulary: football, frog, fan, flag,

Materials

- fan flash cards or objects starting with letter 'f
- Textbook
 flash cards or animals starting with letter 'f

Activities

Brainstorming/Warm up:

- Show students football and ask them "What is this?".
- Talk about it in detail.
- Stress upon the starting sound of ootball.

Development:

Introduce the shape and sound of the leter 'f' through a three-stage lesson focusing on sound recognition.

Activity 1: eccognition/trtroduction/Namin eriod:

- Teacher will show the objects beginning with the phonic leter "f" using flash cards.
- Make them pronounce the leter sound.
- Show them the flash card of fan.

/f/../f/...fan.

Say (say it three times)

This is a fan.

Tell the students that f/.../f/... fan. this is a fan.

• Read pg # 8 aloud with students and make them recognize the pictures.

Identif acation:

• Teacher will place the vocabulary basket in front of students with the objects associated with leter "f". She will show the object e.g. flower by introducing the sound of /f/../f/..flower and she will ask "Show me where is four?"







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3rd stage (Confirmation):

She will show the object e.g. flower and ask "What is this?" (Response: /f/.../f/...flower). Later she will call the students one by one and ask them the same question related to other /f/ sound objects.

Use of 21st Century Skills with STEM Activities:

Science

Tell the students that a frog has long stickytongue to catch insects and other

small prey.





Ask the students to count the number of fingers on their hands.



Sum up:

Repeat the concept by displaying flash cards of letter 'f'.

Assessments

- The teacher will write different letters on the board and ask students to find out letter "f".
- The teacher will show different objects to students and ask students do these all have the initial sound /f/?

Homework

Read letter "f" and its vocabulary from book.


Activities

Student will make leter 'f' in sand tray.


Development:


Sing along with students the rhyme of letter 'f' with actions.
