Topic:

Short sound vowels 'a' (ad,am)



Learning outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students will:

- Recognize the short vowel sound 'a.'
- Read and write CVC words ending in ad and am (e.g., sad, mad, jam, ham).

WALT(We Are Learning To):

 Identify and use the short vowel sound 'a' in words ending with ad and am.

WLIF(What I'm Looking For):

 Students can read, write, and recognize CVC words with ad and am.

Leaning Materials:

- Flashcards (CVC words with ad and am endings).
- · Whiteboard and markers.
- · Worksheets with ad and am words.
- Letter tiles or magnetic letters.



Brainstorming (5 mintues):



- Begin by asking students:
- "Can you think of words that have the a sound in the middle?"
- · Write their responses on the board (e.g., cat, bat, jam, dad).
- · Highlight the words ending with ad and am

Introduction(10 mintues):



- Introduce the short vowel sound 'a' by saying it aloud and asking students to repeat.
- · Write the endings ad and am on the board.
- · Say example words (e.g., sad, mad, jam, ham).



Main Activities (15 mintues):

Activity 1:Flashcard Reading

- · Show flashcards with words like sad, mad, dad, jam, ham, ram.
- · Ask students to read the words aloud.
- · Highlight the short vowel sound 'a' in each word.

Activity 2:Build-a-Word

- · Provide students with letter tiles or magnetic letters.
- · Guide them to build words ending in ad and am (e.g., mad, dad, ham, jam).

Activity 3:Worksheet

Students will complete a worksheet by filling in missing letters to form ad and am words (e.g., m_d, j_m).

Group Activities (20 minutes):

- · Divide students into small groups.
- Each group will create sentences using ad and am words (e.g., Dad is sad or I like jam).
- Share sentences with the class.



Formative Assessment(5 minutes):



- · Listen to students during flashcard reading.
- Check group sentences for correct use of ad and am words.
- · Review worksheets to ensure understanding.

Wrap Up(5 minutes):



- · Review the short vowel sound 'a.'
- · Ask:
- "What sound does the letter 'a' make?"
- · "Can you name a word ending with ad or am?"
