## Topic:

- Short sound vowels 'e' (en,et)



## Learning outcomes:

- By the end of the lesson, students will:
- Recognize and read words with the short e sound in en and et.
  - Use these words to form simple sentences.

## WALT(We Are Learning To):

- Recognize and read en and et words with the short e sound.

## WLIF(What I'm Looking For):

- Correct pronunciation of words with the short e sound.
- Ability to use the words in sentences.

## Leaning Materials:

- Flashcards with words (den, hen, men, ten, net, pet, vet, wet).
- Whiteboard and markers.
- Picture cards for word association.
- Worksheets for practice.



## Brainstorming (5 minutes):



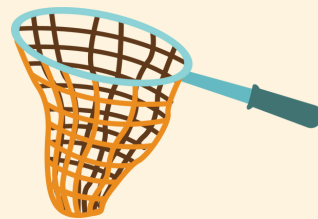
Write hen and pet on the board. Ask students:

- "What sound do you hear in these words?"
- Encourage them to identify other words ending with en and et.

## Introduction(10 minutes):



- Explain the short e sound in en and et with examples:
- en as in men, ten
- et as in net, vet.
- Pronounce the words and have students repeat them.



## Main Activities( 15 minutes):

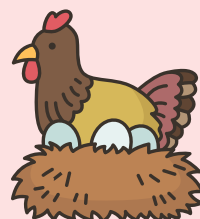


### Activity 1:Word Reading

- Show flashcards of en and et words.
- Students read the words aloud after the teacher.

### Activity 2:Picture Matching

- Provide picture cards (e.g., a hen, a vet, a net).
- Students match the pictures to the correct en or et words.



### Activity 3: Worksheet

- Fill in the blanks with the correct en or et word (e.g., The \_\_ is in the coop).
- Trace and write the words den, ten, pet, wet.



### Group Activities( 20 minutes):



- Divide the class into groups.
- Each group picks a word, acts it out, and others guess (e.g., pretend to hold a pet or point to a net).

### Formative Assessment( 5 minutes):



- Observe students' participation in activities.
- Check the worksheets for correct identification and use of en and et words.

### Wrap Up( 5 minutes):



Ask the students:

- "Name one en word and one et word."
- "Can you form a sentence with one of the words?"

### Home Work:



- Write 2 sentences using en words and 2 sentences using et words.
- Draw a picture for one of the sentences.
