Topic:Numbers (20-29) 2-Digit numbers (In numerals and words)

### **Learning Outcomes:**

- Students will recognize and write numbers from 20 to 29 in numerals and words.
- Students will count objects and associate quantities with numbers.

### Learning Materials:

- Flashcards (numerals and words).
- Counting objects (balls, pencils, etc.).
- Worksheets for writing and matching activities.
- Markers and pencils.

## WALT(We Are Learning To):

• Identify numbers 20-29 and match them with their corresponding words.

# WILF(What I,am Looking For):

 To enhance number recognition and word association skills.

# Brainstroming (5 Mintues):

- Show a set of flashcards (numbers 20-29) and ask students to:
- "What comes after 19?"
- "Can you name this number?"
- "How many objects do you see?" (Show a group of 21 apples, for example).

### Introduction (10 Mintues):

- Recap numbers from 10-19.
- Write "20 to 29" on the board and explain how each number is pronounced and written in words (e.g., twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two).









- · Counting Objects: Provide groups of items (e.g., 20 balls, 25 pencils). Ask students to count the items and say the number aloud.
- · Matching Activity: Give students cards with numerals (20-29) and corresponding word cards. Students will match the numeral to its word.
- · Writing Practice:Provide worksheets with empty spaces to write numbers and their corresponding words.Example: "20 = \_\_\_\_ (in words)."

# Group Activities (20 Mintues):

#### Number Hunt:

- Hide cards with numbers 20-29 around the classroom.
- Students work in pairs to find and write the number with its word.



# Formative Assessment(5 Mintues):

- · Oral quiz: Show flashcards and ask students to say the number and spell it.
- · Check worksheets for accuracy in matching and writing.

### Wrap Up(5 Mintues):

- Write a random sequence of numbers (e.g., 20, 23, 26, 29) on the board.
- · Ask students to say each number aloud and spell it.

### Home Work:

- Practice writing numbers 20-29 in numerals and words twice.
- Draw objects representing any number between 20 and 29 and write the numeral and word.
