Topic:Comparisons of lengths (Long, short)

Learning Outcomes:

- Students will identify objects as long or short
- Students will compare lengths of objects and use the terms "long" and "short" accurately.

Learning Materials:

- Pencils, erasers, and rulers.
- Real objects (e.g., pencils, sticks, ropes).
- Flashcards with "long" and "short".
- Worksheets for practice.

WALT(We Are Learning To):

- Understand and identify long and short objects.
- Use comparative terms to describe lengths.

WILF(What I,am Looking For):

 This will help us describe and compare the lengths of objects in daily life.

Brainstroming (5 Mintues):

- Show two pencils of different lengths. Ask:
- "Which pencil is longer?"
- "Which pencil is shorter?"
- Encourage students to share examples of long and short objects they see around them Introduction (10 Mintues):
- Explain the concept of "long" and "short" using examples.
- · Long: Objects with more length.
- Short: Objects with less length.
- Use real objects to demonstrate and compare.









Main Activities(15 Mintues):

Activity 1:

- Distribute rulers and pencils of different lengths.
- Students measure the lengths and label them as "long" or "short."

Activity 2:

- Provide a set of objects (e.g., ropes, sticks).
- · Ask students to arrange them from shortest to longest.



Group Activities (20 Mintues):

- Divide students into groups.
- Each group receives a set of mixed objects.
- Task: Identify and separate "long" and "short" items.
- Groups present their findings to the class.



Formative Assessment(5 Mintues):

- "Can you show me something long?"
- "Can you show me something short?"
- Observe and guide students during activities.

Wrap Up(5 Mintues):

Recap key points:

- · Long objects have more length.
- · Short objects have less length.
- Encourage students to find examples at home.



- · Complete a worksheet identifying and labeling long and short objects.
- Draw one long object and one short object from home.
