Topic:

CVC words



Learning outcomes:

By the end of the lesson, students will:

- Identify and read CVC words (hat, hen, pin, dog, bun).
- Understand the structure of CVC words (consonant-vowel-consonant).
- Blend and segment sounds in CVC words.

WALT(We Are Learning To):

· Read and recognize CVC words.

WLIF(What I'm Looking For):

Students can blend and read CVC words accurately

Leaning Materials:

- Flashcards (CVC words: hat, hen, pin, dog, bun).
- · Whiteboard and markers.
- · Picture cards of CVC words.
- Worksheets for tracing and filling in missing letters.

Brainstorming (5 mintues):



- · Ask students to guess other words that sound like "hat" or "dog."
- · Highlight the structure of CVC words (e.g., vowel in the middle).

Introduction(10 mintues):



- Begin by introducing the concept of CVC words:
- "CVC words are made up of a consonant, vowel, and consonant, like 'cat' or 'dog'."
- Write the words "hat," "hen," "pin," "dog," and "bun" on the whiteboard.
- Demonstrate blending sounds: "h-a-t makes hat."





Main Activities (15 mintues):

Activity 1:Flashcard Reading

 Show CVC word flashcards and ask students to read the words aloud by blending sounds.

Activity 2: Match the Word to the Picture

- Provide picture cards of "hat," "hen," "pin," "dog," and "bun."
- Students match the correct word flashcard to the corresponding picture.



Activity 3:Worksheet Completion

Students complete a worksheet where they:

- Trace CVC words.
- Fill in missing letters to complete the words (e.g., _h_t, d_g).



Group Activities (20 minutes):



Sound Hunt

- · Divide students into small groups.
- Give them picture cards and ask them to identify the beginning, middle, and ending sounds of each word.

Formative Assessment(5 minutes):



- Observe if students can blend sounds to read words during flashcard activity.
- · Check their ability to fill in missing letters on the worksheet.

Wrap Up(5 minutes):



Recap by asking students to:

- Read all five CVC words aloud.
- Think of one new CVC word.



Home Work:



 Write each CVC word (hat, hen, pin, dog, bun) and draw a picture for each.
